**Paper 1: Reading (1 hour 30 minutes)**

2. You are strongly advised to attempt Part B before Part A. Part B is easier than Part A. Attempt Part B first so that you can build up more confidence before you do Part A.

4. For multiple-choice questions, you are advised to blacken the appropriate circles with a pencil so that wrong marks can be completely erased with a clean rubber. Mark only one answer to each question.

**Paper 2: Writing (1 hour 45 minutes)**

4. Write on every line and skip a line before starting a new paragraph.
5. Analyze the questions carefully. Work out the **text types**, **writing styles** and **readers** of your chosen questions.
6. Then read the questions more carefully in order to *address* them fully in your essay.
7. Edit your work during the exam. Proofread the tenses, spellings and grammar in the last five to ten minutes.

**Text types to be covered:**

1. a letter of advice
2. an argumentative essay
3. a speech
4. an article
